**Day 1: DEPART CANADA**

Board your flight to Tokyo. Cross International dateline.

**Day 2: ARRIVE TOKYO**

Arrive at New Tokyo Int'l Airport and transfer to hotel. (Our staff will meet clients at the exits from customs and assist in boarding an airport bus.)  
Accommodation at Akasaka Prince Hotel for 3 nights.

**Day 3: TOKYO**

Morning city tour : Tokyo Tower, Imperial Palace, Asakusa Kannon Temple, The Tasaki Pearl.  
Afternoon is free.

**Day 4: TOKYO**

Day free at leisure.

**Day 5: TOKYO - MT. FUJI – HAKONE (L)**

Deluxe motor coach to the foot of Mt. Fuji via expressway. Then drive halfway up Japan's highest mountain to enjoy a spectacular view from a height of 2,300 meters. Lunch at Hotel Highland Resort. Afternoon, proceed to Hakone for a cruise on Lake Ashi and visit to Owakudani Valley.  
Accommodation at Hotel Kowaki-en with hot spring baths.

**Day 6: HAKONE - NAGOYA – TOBA (L)**

Morning drive through the Hakone mountains to Odawara Station and ride a Shinkansen train to Nagoya. After lunch at Hotel Associa Nagoya Terminal, start for sightseeing in Nagoya, visiting Nagoya Castle and Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry and Technology. (When the museum is

closed, visit Osu Kannon Temple instead). Late afternoon, continue train trip to Toba by Kintetsu's limited-express train.

Accommodation at Toba Hotel International.

**Day 7: TOBA - ISE – KYOTO (L)**

Morning visit to Mikimoto Pearl Island to see the process of cultured pearls and women pearl divers at work. Delicious seafood lunch (or meat, if preferred) at the hotel. Afternoon drive to Ise-Jingu Shrine, Japan's most sacred Shinto center. Then proceed to Uji-Yamada Station and board a limited-express train for the classical city of Kyoto.  
Accommodation at New Miyako Hotel for 3 nights.

**Day 8: KYOTO - NARA – KYOTO (L)**

Morning sightseeing of the city, visiting Golden Pavilion, Nijo Castle noted for its gorgeous interiors, and Kyoto Imperial Palace (on Sat., Sun. & national holidays: visit Higashi Honganji Temple instead). After lunch at Kyoto Handicraft Center, excursion to Nara, the first permanent capital of Japan. Visit Todaiji Temple housing Great Buddha, colorful Kasuga Shrine with 3,000 lanterns, and Deer Park where many tame deer are freely roaming.  
Return to Kyoto.

**Day 9: KYOTO**

Day free at leisure

**Day 10: DEPART FROM OSAKA**

Transfer to KANSAI Int'l Airport for departure.
